The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) cordially invites you to attend a public hearing concerning the improvement of IL 31 from IL 176 to IL 120 in McHenry County. The scope of work consists of roadway widening and reconstruction to provide two lanes in each direction separated by a median, intersection and drainage improvements, and pedestrian and bicycle improvements. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain public input on the preferred alternative and Environmental Assessment (EA). A public forum will begin at **6:00 pm**, where the public will be invited to make a statement to a court reporter. The EA is also available on the project website, Prairie Grove Village Hall, McHenry Public Library, and the Department's District One office in Schaumburg. Comments will be accepted through **March 10, 2017**.
